NCVA HP will secure a group flight for the trip, the NCVA will charge the parents at a later time for the flight tickets. Players will be given guidelines for travel and are required to always travel with the team. Ground transportation, meals, and sightseeing costs are all included in the price listed above. If a parent would like to travel with the player, it's an additional \$2600 (includes, SHARED hotel room, meals, ground transportation, sightseeing costs), plus an additional \$800 for a single room (if two parents are coming, DO NOT purchase the additional \$800, as we will room them together in a shared hotel room).

### **Tryouts & Notification**

Players will be notified if they are selected for a team or selected as an alternate, **starting** in mid-late February.

- Players will receive an email from NCVA. Players will be given 48 hours to confirm their position, and make the initial deposit.
- Once a player is confirmed, they are posted on the website.
- After a team is filled, alternates will be selected and invited to participate. Should any player be unable to travel, an alternate would be invited in their place.
